


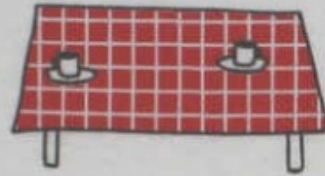

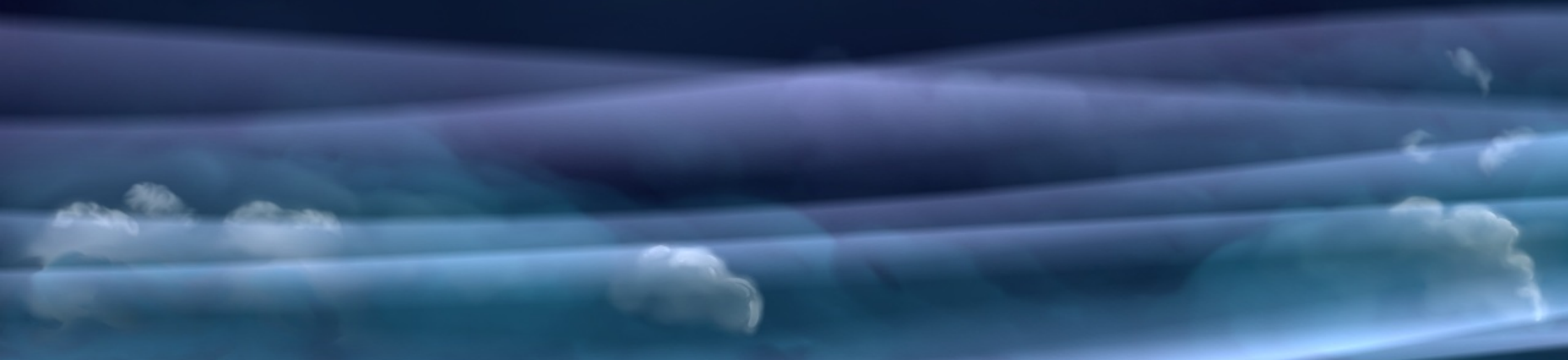

One Fedora for all

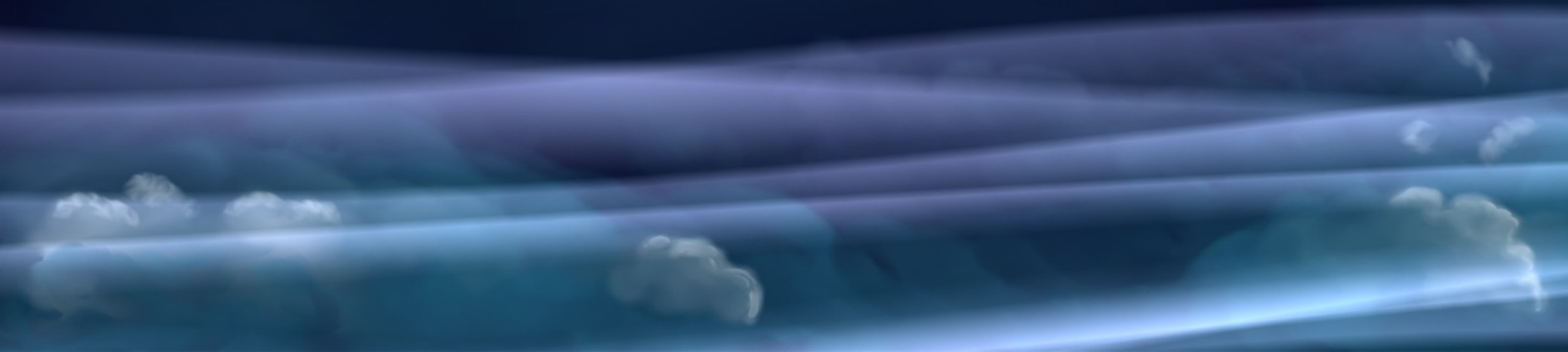
- One release that has to fit all usecases

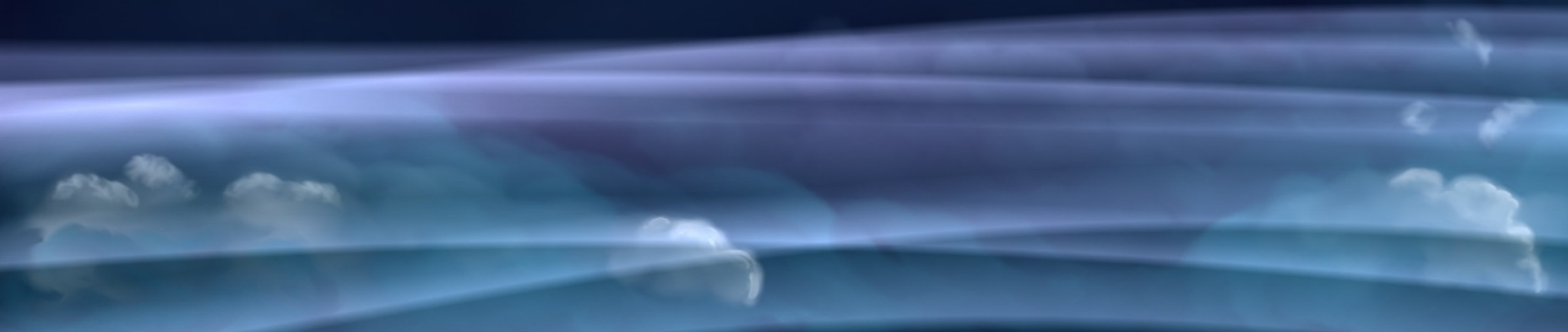

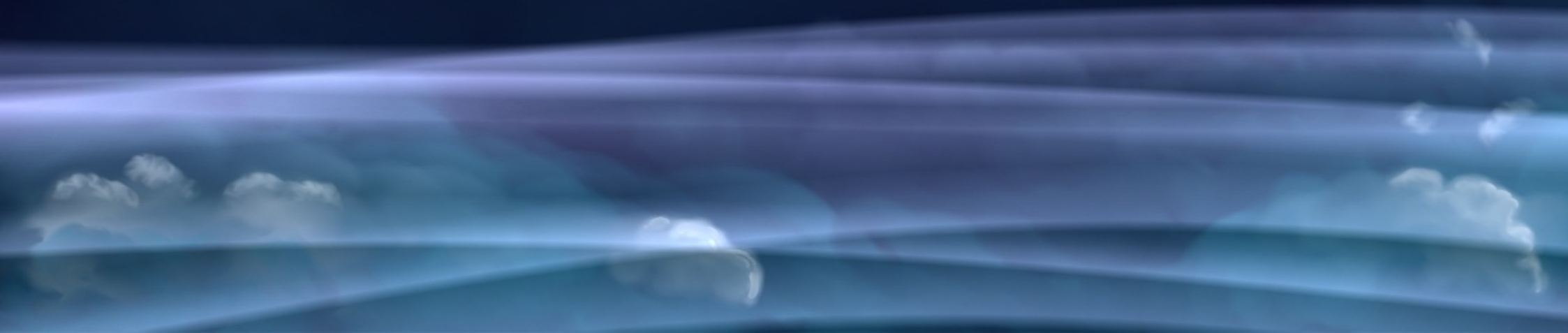
